Frontier Airlines Wows Weekend Travelers

Customers Receive Exceptional Service and On-Time Flights

DENVER (April 14, 2008) – Frontier Airlines Holdings, Inc. (NASDAQ: FRNT) spent the weekend reconfirming what long-time customers already knew—that Frontier is one of the most on-time airlines in the industry. Over the weekend, Frontier flew a full schedule of 1,201 flights, with 99.9% of all flights completed and 81% of those flights arriving on time. Frontier’s flights also featured a load factor of more than 83%. The airline’s passenger numbers continue to hold strong with close to 75,000 weekend travelers flying Frontier. Customers took notice of the airlines’ continued outstanding service, from the friendly and professional customer service agents to the pleasant flight experience provided by Frontier’s pilots and flight crew.

“We are so thankful and inspired by the wonderful support of our customers,” said Frontier CEO Sean Menke. “We received countless notes of encouragement over the weekend from people who tell us that Frontier is their favorite airline, and they will continue to fly us without question. Our promise to our customers is that they will continue to receive the same service they’ve come to expect from Frontier. It is business as usual for our customers going forward, and they should feel confident in booking with Frontier for all their future travel.”

Frontier Airlines Holdings, Inc. announced on April 10, 2008 that Frontier and its subsidiaries had filed voluntary petitions for reorganization under Chapter 11 of the U.S. Bankruptcy Code. The airline will maintain normal operations throughout the reorganization.
